Richard Kay has been Lawrences' picture expert for eighteen years. A History of Art graduate, he spent over 14 years at Sothebys and Phillips. He lives near Dorchester, writing regularly for a number of publications including "Antique Collecting". Richard has entertained & informed us through his lectures for the last 12 years; we are most grateful for his support of the RNLI

This talk, a revised and edited version of a talk first given to the RNLI in 2012, celebrates 30 remarkable images of some of Britain's monarchs. Portraits that show the bombastic Majesty of Henry VIII, the thwarted monarchy of Charles I, the tragic life of Queen Anne, the relentless decades of mourning by Victoria, the disrupted reign of Edward VIII, the overarching splendour of our late Queen's 70-year reign and many others will be assessed through pictures from the eras that they defined. As we celebrate the start of the first year of the reign of King Charles III, this talk will hope to show just how far we have travelled since the days of Holbein, Van Dyck and Allan Ramsay – sometimes for better, sometimes for worse.
